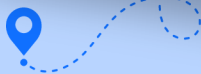

A school tour to Stratford-upon-Avon where the world-famous playwright William Shakespeare was born and lived has the potential to inspire your pupils.

WALKING TOUR OF SHAKESPEARE'S STRATFORD-UPON-AVON

A 2 hour walk around the Stratford streets that 'brings Shakespeare back to life' – Shakespeare's life story set in the context of historic Stratford. All seven ages of this man of Stratford are explored in depth with a little help from the writings of 'our myriad-minded Shakespeare'.

SHAKESPEARE'S BIRTHPLACE & EXHIBITION

William Shakespeare's birthplace is one of the most evocative attractions in the world and undoubtedly the centrepiece of any visit to Stratford-upon-Avon. See Shakespeare's home as he would have lived in it as a 10 year old boy. Based on meticulous research, the birthplace's parlour, hall, bedrooms, kitchen and buttery are furnished in authentic 16th-century style. Dwell in the chambers where he and his seven brothers and sisters were born and view the glove makers workshop where as a boy, Shakespeare would have watched his father work. Investigate the window where 19th century pilgrims to the Birthplace scratched their signatures and hunt out the famous. Explore the house which features stunning room displays, highlights of which include traditional linen wall hangings, a textile hung bed and rare pieces of everyday furniture. The Shakespeare Exhibition illustrates Shakespeares life and career in both Stratford and London. It includes a first edition of Shakespeare's collected plays and a model of London's Globe Theatre.



MANCHESTER MUSEUM OF SCIENCE & INDUSTRY

The Museum of Science and Industry (MOSI) in Manchester, England, is a large museum devoted to the development of science, technology and industry with emphasis on the city's achievements in these fields. The museum is part of the Science Museum Group, a non-departmental public body of the Department for Culture, Media and Sport, having merged with the National Science Museum in 2012. There are extensive displays on the theme of transport (cars, aircraft, railway locomotives and rolling stock), power (water, electricity, steam and gas engines), Manchester's sewerage and sanitation, textiles, communications and computing.



CADBURY WORLD

So where and when did the magic begin? Thousands of years ago is the answer, in the ancient Maya and Aztec civilizations of Central America. Cocoa trees grew wild in the jungle, and they used them to make a spicy, rather bitter drink for special occasions. Centuries later the Aztec Empire fell, and the Conquistador Hernan Cortés brought cocoa beans back across the ocean to Spain. Gradually chocolate spread across Europe – it was the fashionable choice of Kings and Queens, the nobility and the rich, just like caviar or champagne today. At the end of the 19th Century milk was added, and at last someone devised a way of making chocolate to eat as well as to drink. But it wasn't until the 20th century that chocolate became affordable for everyone. So chocolate has been on an epic journey, but its popularity is enduring; prized once by Aztec warriors and today by millions of people around the world.
